



DECLARATION OF COMMITMENT OF THE NETWORK CENTER FOR BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH IN NEURODEGENERATIVE DISEASES (CIBERNED) TO THE PRINCIPLES OF THE EUROPEAN CHARTER FOR RESEARCHERS AND THE CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE RECRUITMENT OF RESEARCHERS.
